I would like to personally thank you for entrusting myself and staff in the management of your healthcare. I have always tried to distinguish our practice by being available and accessible to our patients, providing a detailed and thorough assessment of patients with emphasis on preventative care, and involving our patients as integral members of our healthcare team approach.

To better serve our patients, North Providence Primary Care has recently relocated to our new home at the Mineral Spring Medical Commons, at the corner of Mineral Spring Avenue and Smithfield Road. We are proud to offer a complete, barrier free examination room for patients who are wheelchair bound or who cannot transfer to an exam table, which allows for comprehensive examinations.

Our new facility is also designed to provide a comprehensive service to our patients with such services available including x-ray, ultrasound, full laboratory services on site offered by University of Massachusetts Patient Service Center, and affiliation with North Providence Urgent Care, a complete urgent care center to attend to your acute medical needs 7 days a week with complete access to your medical information for a thorough and complete evaluation. North Providence Urgent Care is located on the first floor and is complete with a procedure room, orthopedic room, emergency/telemetry room complete with a defibrillator, oxygen, and code cart. It is staffed by a physician skilled in urgent care and a nurse and radiological technician. As a patient, you will have the ability to schedule an appointment with the urgent care facility for any acute problems whether it be nights or weekends.

Should you require reaching us after hours, our practice is available to you for direction of your medical needs. We cover our patients and only our patients, and your call will always be answered by a member of our practice. My practice is affiliated with Miriam Hospital. Should you require hospitalization, we are in close contact with the Miriam hospitalists who will provide 24 hour care to you throughout your hospital stay and report to us your hospital plan.

Please complete the enclosed packet and bring it with you on the day of your visit. I request that you also obtain any medical records from your prior primary care office or any hospital, testing or lab reports that are pertinent. If you do need assistance, please feel free to contact our front desk at (401)351-1900. I do urge all morning patients to arrive after fasting for 12 hours, in case lab work needs to be obtained at your visit.
